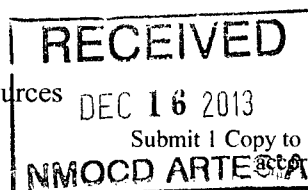

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* The well was shut in and the stuffing box packing was replaced.					
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Approximately 7250 sq. ft. of caliche well pad was affected by the leak. Initial heavily saturated soils were removed from the surface of the impacted area. The site was excavated to 1.5 ft. below ground surface. Soil samples were collected from the excavation bottom. The samples were field screened and submitted to a commercial laboratory for chloride and TPH confirmation. The site was backfilled with caliche and the area was dressed.
