Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* A 1 inch corroded hole on the bull plug, located on the back bottom part of the north above ground storage tank (AST) was discovered.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Pulled all the oil out of the north tank and transferred it to the south tank which totaled to about 75 barrels. We were able to pick up about 7 barrels off the ground and put it in the operational tank. Have ~4 barrels in some areas that were too muddy to pick up. All of it is contained within secondary containment. The cleanup crew dug up all of the contaminated soil and they will haul it off proper disposal. After the repairs to the AST they will lay a new base. The dyke is lined so the oil could only penetrate to the lining.
