The project area for these wells include the W/2 W/ 2 of Section 11; and W/2 E/2 Section 17, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Prodigal Sun 17 24 34 Federal Well No. 1H central tank battery (CTB) located in Unit B, Section 17, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.

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This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management before commencing commingling operations.
