- 1. Install erosion control measures in the pasture-affected areas to prevent the unconsolidated reclamation materials from washing or blowing away until reclaimed areas settle and begin to re vegetate.
- 2. Rip and seed reclaimed and equipment-impacted pasture areas with BLM seed mix #2 and #4, 50/50 mix.
- 3. Berm the north side of the location to ensure any future spills stay on the location.
- 4. Continue to monitor spill reclamation area to ensure impacted pasture areas re vegetate and that erosion issues do not develop.

Other Stipulations:
