Ike,

Tetra Tech's remediation proposal was approved (with conditions of approval) by Terry Gregston (BLM) on January 30, 2012. A subsequent proposal submitted by CURA, was denied by Ms. Gregston on February 5, 2013. In a meeting with Josh Russo on February 7, 2013, he indicated that the CURA proposal was not authorized by COG, but had been initiated by Ferguson Construction, the entity that had breached the flowline during unrelated excavation operations. At this time, NMOCD approves the Tetra Tech proposal (original submittal dated January 16, 2012), and concurs with BLM in denying the CURA proposal.

Updated approval may be required by BLM.

Please notify me in the event the proposed excavation depths are not achieved, and prior to installation of liner/liners.
