On 8-17-10 at 3:00pm a leak occurred on the Antelope 8" SWD lateral line. A portion of the line became uncovered and weathered, weakening the pipe and causing it to rupture. 80 bbls of produced water was released. We were unable to recover any fluids due to the spill location and absorption rate. Line has been repaired but was left out of service pending integrity evaluation. The contaminated area is 12ft X 90ft. We will await instruction before performing any cleanup of the area. The airplane reported "no leaks" at 9:00am of the same day.
