Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* A four inch check valve on the header failed and released 71 barrels of produced water and 30 barrels of oil to the ground surface, there was also several areas where the fluid did get off the well pad. Area one was north of the battery and pipeline valve settings, area two was an overspray area to the northwest of the battery. Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The spill impacted approximately 18,900 sq. ft. of pad area, caliche lease road and pasture area. The release also misted approximately 11,500 sq. ft. of pasture. BOPCO plans to spray the overspray area with a Micro-Blaze mix and have a backhoe conduct surface scrape on the areas that are accessible. The spill will be cleaned up in accordance to the NMOCD and BLM remediation guidelines.

This email is to inform you that BOPCO had a release at the PLU 261 battery. A four inch check valve on the header failed and released 71 barrels of produced water and 30 barrels of oil to the ground surface, there was also several areas where the fluid did get off the well pad. Area one was north of the battery and pipeline valve settings, area two was a overspray area to the northwest of the battery. BOPCO plans to spray the overspray area down with a micro-blaze mix and have a backhoe conduct surface scrape on the areas that are assessable. I will follow up with an initial C-141. If you have any questions of concerns please let me know.

Jim, we would like to also scrape up the saturated areas in the pasture (north of the battery and pipeline valve settings). As seen in the attached Google earth image. Please let me know if there are any issues with conducting the pasture scrape, It looks to be within the ROW.
