The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Perdomo BMP State Com. No. 1H central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit L, of Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.
