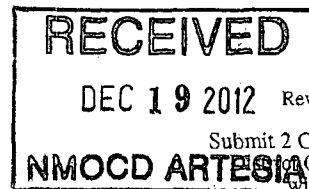

Pump failure caused 3 bbls of oil and 100 bbls of produced water to leak onto the ground. A vacuum truck recovered the remaining fluids, 80 bbls total. The pump was repaired.

The area affected is approximately 100' x 50'. A vacuum truck recovered 80 bbls and further remediation will be conducted in accordance with OCD and BLM approved remediation plans.

Gentlemen, this email is to initially report that OXY had a Reportable spill at the Federal 12-1 South Battery yesterday, Sec 12 T22s R31e Eddy Co. This was due to a pump failure at the location. It caused the tanks to over fill and spill 3 bbls of oil and 100 bbls of produce water into the surrounding dyke. A vac truck was dispatched and recovered all remaining fluids from the surface soils, 80 bbls total. This site will be remediated to NMOCD and BLM guidelines. A C-141 is to follow.
