Dear Mr. Jones,

Transwestern Pipeline Company, LLC, (Transwestern) is in receipt of your June 9, 2017 voice mail notification concerning Transwestern's omission to comply with permit condition No. 3 and provide a 72 hour oral or written notification for each hydrostatic test water discharge event which occurred for the time period of May 12, 2016 to May 12, 2017. Upon discussions with our Engineering Department it was determined that Transwestern did not submit the required 72 hour notification for the eight (8) hydrostatic test water discharges completed for the above referenced time period.

Transwestern understands the responsibility to fully comply with all conditions in the Annual Temporary Permit (HBP-33) issued to Transwestern and has taken the following measures to ensure that this reporting oversight will not happen for any future hydrostatic discharge events.

- 1) Transwestern will provide a training program within 30 days of the date of this letter and require all individuals involved in performing hydrostatic discharges to attend the training. The training will include detailed instruction on the permit conditions in HBP-033, focusing on the requirement to notify to the OCD within 72 hours of each discharge.
- 2) The contractor responsible for the eight (8) hydrostatic discharges reported in the 2017 Annual Report will no longer be conducting hydrostatic test water discharges for Transwestern.




