The project area for these wells comprises the N/2 N/2 of Section 20, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Commingled oil and gas production from the wells shall be measured and sold at the Rigel "20" Federal Com. Well No. 1H tank battery, located in Unit D of Section 20, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be separately metered before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C(2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules and Regulations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) before commencement of the commingling operations.

The producer/Operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority and the Artesia District Office of the Division prior to implementation of commingling operations.
