Reference is made to your September 2005 letter requesting this Division administrative order to be vacated. The Division has received a copy of this letter signed by each of you.

It is our understanding that a proper spacing unit for the Tubb was not obtained and that all production from this well is from the Tubb formation. Therefore, this downhole commingle permit is not proper and is not needed.

Accordingly, administrative order DHC-3086 <u>is hereby vacated</u> as of the date shown above. Production shall remain segregated by pool within this wellbore.
