We had a spill at the Bonnie 35 Federal Com Battery last night 6/18/2015 due to a hammer union on the water transfer line vibrating loose due to pressure. We had 15 barrels of produce water hit the ground and we were only able to recover 5 barrels of produced water, the fluids were not contained but did stay on location.
