


Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* An approximate area of 120' X 15' was affected within the bermed battery. The valves were closed and approximately 90% (9 B/O) of the produced water was recovered using a vacuum truck. Impacted soils are to be remediated in-place with micro-blaze and applications of nitrogen fertilizer (3, 30 day applications). The area of impacted soils will be sampled for TPH/BTEX and chlorides (for documentation) to insure that contaminants are below RRAL's for a site ranking of Zero (0). Depth to Ground Water: > 100' (approximately 250', per ChevronTexaco Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0. Based on the battery being bermed, the majority of the released produced water recovered and in-place remediation, Yates Petroleum Corporation requests closure.
