Dear Ms. Staley:

The Farmington District Office (FDO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has received your letter dated March 18, 1996, for downhole commingling of the Blanco Mesaverde and Basin Dakota Pools in the above referenced well.

The Dakota formation is producing 60 MCFD and .22 BCPD with a BTU value of 1122, and the Mesaverde is producing 80 MCFD and .21 BCPD with a BTU value of 1196. Corrected bottom hole pressures are 617 psi for the Mesaverde and 753 psi for the Dakota. Using these values, the fixed percentage for allocated production for each formation has been determined as follows:

FORMATION	GAS PRODUCTION	OIL PRODUCTION
Blanco Mesaverde	57%	50%
Basin Dakota	43%	50%

Approval to downhole commingle the Blanco Mesaverde and Basin Dakota formations for the above referenced well is hereby granted.
