Pipeline corrosion is the suspected cause of the release. Pumping sources immediately shut down and the flow path was diked. A vacuum truck was mobilized to the location. Impacted soils at the source were excavated and placed on a plastic liner to allow repairs to the line.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Flow path was in the Aero road south ditch. Delineation and remediation efforts were conducted by SESI of Hobbs, NM and closure documentation submitted to the NMOCD on 07-03-13.
