

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The steel coupler on the well head failed due to high pressure and vibration causing 80 bbls of produced water to leak onto the ground. A vacuum truck recovered 70 bbls of produced water and the coupler was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The affected area is approximately 85' x 40' on location. Remediation will be completed in accordance with a remediation plan approved by NMOCD and the BLM.

Subject: Lost Tank 33 Federal #2 SWD

This is to inform you that Oxy Permian had a leak at the Lost Tank 33 Federal #2 SWD on September 3, 2015. Oxy spilled 80 bbls of produced water due to vibration and high pressure on a half-inch steel coupler on the well head. The preliminary report shows the leak measuring approximately 40' x 80' on location. A vacuum truck recovered approximately 70 bbls of a produced water. The release is located at U/L M, Section 33, T21S, R31E of Eddy County, NM. BBC International will remediate the location at a later date and an initial C-141 will follow. Driving directions: At NM128 on Whipp Rd, go north to the government facility about 4-5 miles, go ¼ mile past mile marker 4 and turn left at the up-rights, turn right at cattleguard, go west at first battery, SWD is 300 yds past 4-1 battery.
