Attached is a copy of the allocation for the commingling of the subject well for the Lewis pay add that was completed 7-31-01. DHC-1517 was issued for this well.

Gas:	Mesaverde Dakota	33% 67%
Oil:	Mesaverde Dakota	41% 59%

These percentages were calculated using rate-time reserve estimate comparisons for each respective formation. Because the Lewis formation was the only formation added during operations, the oil allocation has stayed the same as it was prior to working over the well.
