Your application applying for downhole commingling approval for the Basin Fruitland Coal and WAW Pictured Cliffs formation in the above referenced well. The estimated bottom hole pressures are 125 psi for the Pictured Cliffs and 225 psi for the Fruitland. Allocation will be done using the subtraction method, projecting the Pictured Cliffs production and then taking the difference to calculate the Fruitland production.
