

Enclosed is an Amended Form C-107-A to reflect the change in the field names from the Pitchfork Ranch Wolfcamp & Pitchfork Ranch Strawn Fields to the Undesignated Fairview Mills Woldcamp Gas and Wildcat Strawn Fields. This change was requested by Mr. Mike Stogner as we also filed for an unorthodox bottom hole location to sidetrack a direction hole from the existing vertical well.

None of the information or attachments have changed on this application other than correcting the field names. All of the offsets were given the proper notification of the original package and a copy of the certified return receipts were mailed to you as proof of notification.
