Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A bell hole was dug down to the leak and a clamp affixed to immediately contain the leak. Additional repairs may be needed at which time this C-141 will be updated to reflect the final repairs if needed and required.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The area affected was largely pasture and the ROW next to the pipeline. A vacuum truck was used to remove all the free liquid from the surface. The ROW was scraped and back dragged to remove any contaminated soil that resulted from the spray of material. Any wet soil was removed and placed on a bermed, plastic area to await further remedial actions. The remainder of the contaminated soil will be removed and the area sampled to confirm cleanup as per OCD guidance. The final report will describe the remedial actions in more detail. Please note the time and volume of material lost/recovered are estimations more accurate estimates will be included with the final report as well.
