
Mr. Goetz,

Trinity Environmental SWD, LLC, as operator, has received funding for re-entry of the subject well, and conversion to SWD. Funding took longer than originally anticipated due to the crash in the oil price. Location work has commenced and a pulling unit is scheduled to move in next Tuesday. The previous extension on the subject permit expires on November 16, 2015, which is 40 days from today. In order to protect the rather large investment that is being made in this site, Trinity respectfully requests a three month extension of the expiration date for the subject permit to February 16, 2016. This order has been extended twice in the past due to delays in the BLM permitting process. Trinity diligently pursued the BLM for approval of the re-entry APD originally filed by Judah in May of 2014. Now that funding has been obtained, this project will move towards completion.

To support our request, a review of the ownership and well information in the Area of Review was conducted. There were no changes in the number of wells or their status. Since field operations have been initiated, a timely reply would be greatly appreciated.
