Crude oil overflowed from a tank truck while driver was loading the truck from the LACT unit. The LACT unit was turned off upon discovery of the spill preventing more oil from being spilled. The root cause is being investigated.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

67 barrels of crude oil were spilled onto the site, and all spilled material remained on the site. 44 barrels were recovered via vacuum truck. The impacted area has been barricaded to prevent traffic over the area. LPC is working with the pad owner to coordinate remediation.

Please accept this email and the attached C-141 as confirmation of initial notification and initial spill report for a 67 bbl spill (44 recovered) by LPC Crude Oil Marketing, LLC that occurred in Eddy County at N 32° 09' 9.41"; W 103° 43' 38.37" on 11/11/15 at 10:30 PM. This spill from the transport truck occurred on a Devon pad (Cotton Draw 172H) and did not leave the site. A vacuum truck was able to recover 44 bbl of spilled crude oil.
