COG Operating, LLC (OGRID 229137) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (97565) from the following leases and wells:

Lease: Bone Yard 11 Fee Well No. 11H Lease
Description: W/2 W/2 of Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM
Well: Bone Yard 11 Fee Well No. 11H

Lease: Bone Yard 11 Fee Well No. 12H Lease
Description: E/2 W/2 of Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM
Well: Bone Yard 11 Fee Well No. 12H

Lease: Grave Digger State Com. Well No. 8H Lease
Description: E/2 W/2 of Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM
Well: Grave Digger State Com. Well No. 8H

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Bone Yard 11 Fee Well No. 12H central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit N, of Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the same lease in the same project area approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
