


Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The leak affected 840 ft <sup>2</sup> of pasture west of the tanks and 2,064 ft <sup>2</sup> of well pad. Vacuum truck recovered standing fluids and the impacted well pad area was fenced off to prevent traffic spread.
