This API # is operated by Apache

To follow up on our earlier conversations, we had a small fire at the Jackson B 6 Battery on 1/13/16. We believe the incident was caused by gas in the FWKO which did not allow the heater treater to work properly. The fire covered a small area approximately 5'x5'. Our lease operators were in the field and quickly shut down the wells going to this location. The fire was quickly extinguished and no one was hurt.

Once I have further information, I will submit the C-141.
