A faulty gate valve allow the mid-pressure system to flow into the low pressure system flowline, causing the flowline to overpressure and rupture. Impacted soil was scraped off the road and stockpiled on location. The site will be delineated and remediated on-site.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Condensate was released onto Stateline Road, where it migrated down the roadway. Impacted material was mechanically scraped rom road surface to avoid interference with traffic. Impacted material was stockpiled on location.
