Gentlemen,

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As per the attached letter, Nadel & Gussman/Heyco is going to propose an onsite disposal of soils, contaminated as a result of the recent blow out on their Rock Island 16 St 1H well. The contaminated material would be stabilized with CKD and then trench buried. The site is situated on the New Mexico State University Experimental Station property just South of Artesia. (G-16-18s-26e) If you want to Google it: N32.74896 W104.38367

There are several residences in the vicinity and an abundance of water wells. State engineer shows 8 pages in 185-26e, 3 pages in the immediately surrounding sections, and 3 wells with depth to water data in section 16. The wells in section 16 show depth water at 130', 100' and 51'.

I advised the contractor that I could not approve the proposal at the District level, and that it may have to go through hearing process to be considered, but she (Cheryl Winkler) seems pretty intent on trying to get it approved. I do not think the NG/Heyco rep is as enthusiastic about it, especially when I mentioned going to hearing.

I haven't seen any analytical data yet, but we should have it in a day or so.
