This message is to confirm our discussion of today, July 28, 2011 concerning the remediation plan for the Chesapeake H & K 18 Federal #1 leak site. Per our discussion and agreement, Chesapeake will excavate the

impacted soil across the site to a depth of 3 feet or as practicable and backfill the site with clean caliche. As we discussed, Chesapeake had already begun the excavation prior to our meeting. In addition, Chesapeake will collect sidewall confirmation samples of the excavation area and analyze for TPH, BTEX, and Chloride. When the battery is rebuild, it will be a lined facility. I have attached the lab data and diagrams that we reviewed for your files.
