Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The released crude oil impacted an area measuring approximately 148' x 60' inside the facility. The impacted area was remediated per NMOCD recommended guidelines. Soil samples collected from the floor and sidewalls of the excavation were analyzed by an NMOCD-approved laboratory, and concentrations of benzene. BTEX, TPH, and chloride were below the recommended remediation action levels established for the site by the NMOCD.
