COG Operating, LLC (OGRID 229137) is hereby authorized to transport and measure oil and gas production off-lease, from the following well which produces from Corral Canyon; Bone Spring, South Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico:

Big Papi Federal Com. Well No. 2 H (API No. 30-015-37833), Unit C, Section 4, T-26S, R-29E

The project area for this well includes the E/2 W/2 of Section 4, Township 26 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from this well shall be measured at, and sold from, Big Papi Federal Com. Well No. 1 H Central Tank Battery located in Unit B, Section 4, Township 26 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. All meters for the above-referenced well shall be physically separated from facilities for other wells, so that production from the above-referenced well will not be commingled prior to measurement with production from any other well.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:

The oil and gas production from this well shall be separately metered using sales meters.


The surface commingling of oil and gas with production from other pools or leases is NOT authorized.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District Office of the Division before commencement of Off-Lease Measurement.

The approval is subject to like approval by the Bureau of Land Management.
