

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A D-6 Caterpillar Bulldozer operated by a 3rd Party struck a 6-inch steel pipeline, slip-lined with 4-inch poly pipe. The resulting pipeline release did not cause any fire, injury or property damage. The pipeline was shut in, repairs were completed and the pipeline was placed back in service.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

This release was initially deemed non-reportable to the NMOCD. During remediation activities, Southern Union opted to reclassify this release as a reportable release, due to the depth of soil impact. The remediation of this release is in progress and this release will be remediated to NMOCD regulatory standards.
