I. This proposed 4840' deep oil well is on BLM surface and a BLM oil and gas lease. The well is nonstandard (25' too far south) for the Red Lake; Glorieta-Yeso, NE Pool (96836) due to archaeology (see EXHIBIT A). The \geq 85 year old remains of the Pecos Diamond Refinery and pump station are at a standard location. The refinery has site number LA 102896.

Lime Rock requests a nonstandard location due to archaeology. The SESE Section 5 is also occupied by 2 P&A wells and 2 active oil wells and crossed by 2 county roads, 3 CVE electric distribution lines, 1 SW Public Service 115 kV line, 1 City of Carlsbad water line, 1 Frontier gas line, 1 Nearburg saltwater line, 5 Lime Rock saltwater lines, 2 Lime Rock flowlines, 2 Lime Rock gas lines, and miscellaneous roads.

A standard location must be \geq 330' from the boundary of the quarterquarter. In this case, the well will be 305' from the south side of unit letter P.

II. Form C-102 showing the well and 40-acre dedication is attached as Exhibit B. The well is 25' too far south. Closest existing Glorieta-Yeso well is Lime Rock's Compton 5 P Federal 4 (30-015-41439), 852' northeast.

III. Lease boundary is shown on EXHIBIT C. The well encroaches to the south, southwest, and west. Red Lake; Glorieta-Yeso, NE (96836) or Red Lake; Glorieta-Yeso (51120) dedications (EXHIBIT D) exist in unit letter P of Section 5 and two of the bordering or cornering quarter-quarters (NESE Sec. 5 (Lime Rock) and NENE Sec. 8 (Devon)). No existing Glorieta-Yeso dedications are in the remaining bordering or cornering quarter-quarters. This information is current and correct.

IV. Archaeology is an issue. Well was originally staked at a standard location (330 FSL & 915 FEL). Based on the contract archaeologist's recommendation of site LA 102896 as being ineligible for the Nation Register, an APD was filed

on September 4, 2015. Upon further government review, Lime Rock was asked to move the well pad out of the archaeology site. A Sundry was then filed on November 25, 2015 to reflect the 25' move. (Lime Rock is working with BLM to transmit 100% of the Sundry to OCD.) Even after the move, due to the site proximity, Lime Rock will hire a contract archaeologist to monitor construction.

V. Surface issues (archaeology, wells, power lines, pipelines, roads, and other infrastructure) and the need to prevent waste and recover additional reserves drive the need for this nonstandard location. Directional drilling to a standard location is not economically feasible.

VI.
