The combined project area for these wells include E/2 of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 33, East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold Eland State Well central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit P, of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each of the identically-owned leases shall be measured with allocation meters.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
