Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

A 3" below grade FG flow line split, the line was immediately shut-in, the line was excavated and then repaired. Excavation for the repair uncovered evidence of a historic release at this location. The historic release occurred prior to acquisition of the lease by Lime Rock. The release caused by the flow line split was less than 5 bbls.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

The area affected by the historic release is on the edge of Fanning road (CR-44) and was measured to be 15L'x15W'. Additional evaluation is required to determine if the historic release was in such quantity as may with reasonable probability be detrimental to water or exceed the standards in Subsections A and B or C of 19.15.30.9 NMAC. Lime Rock will voluntarily provide the results of the additional investigations to OCD and, if necessary, a remediation plan consistent with Part 29.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment.
