Allocation Formula Method:

3 Hour Flow Test from Mesaverde = 1,619 MCFD & 0 BO

3 Hour Flow Test from Dakota = 269 MCFD & 0 BO

GAS:

$$\frac{(MV) 1,619 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV \& DK) 1,888 \text{ MCFD}} = (MV) \% \text{ Mesaverde 86\%}$$

$$\frac{(DK) 269 \text{ MCFD}}{(MV \& DK) 1,888 \text{ MCFD}} = (DK) \% \text{ Dakota 14\%}$$

OIL:
