Mr. Bratcher,

This letter is in regards to our conversation on September 14, 2010 regarding the Range SCB 23-19 Injection Facility. In that conversation it was stated that due to Centreion Pipeline is on the east side of release area approximately 25' from the end, that it will be okay to excavate the first foot of soils and transport to disposal facility and 4' west of line. West of the pipeline will continue being excavated to a depth of 4'bgs with a 20-mil liner installed. Once liner is installed the entire excavation area will be backfilled.
