The affected area is approximately 105' x 76' on location. Remediation will be completed in accordance with an approved remediation plan from NMOCD and the BLM.

This is to inform you that Oxy-Permian had a release at the Peaches 19 Federal CTB on 11/16/2016 in Eddy County, NM. Oxy released 50 bbls of produced water due to a compromised 3" steel water line. The preliminary report indicates the leak measures 25' x 75' on location. Recovery is in progress. The release is located in Section 19, T25S, R27E of Eddy County. Driving directions: From Malaga, go South on US 285 to mile marker 5, turn right(west) on White City Rd(CR724) and go 11.4 miles to CR 742(Old Cavern Hwy), turn right(north) 3.8 miles to Oxy Peaches CTB sign, turn right(east) and go 0.7 miles to Big Battery(CTB) on left(north) and follow downhill to battery.
