Matador Production Company (OGRID 228937) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from the Black River; Wolfcamp, East Gas Pool (Pool code: 97442) from the following diversely owned fee leases located in Township 23 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico:

Lease: Charlie Sweeney 31 23S 28E RB Well 201H Lease
Description: W/2 of Section 31, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM
Well: Charlie Sweeney 31 23S 28E RB Well 201H API 30-015-43695

Lease: Jim Tom Lontos 30 23S 28E RB Well No. 221H; Division Order R-14197
Description: W/2 of Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM
Wells: Jim Tom Lontos 30 23S 28E Well No. 221H API 30-015-43826

The combined project area for these wells include W/2 of Section 30, and W/2 of Section 31, Township 23 South, Range 28, East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold Charlie Sweeney 31 23S 28E RB Well No. 201H Well central tank battery (CTB), located in Lot 4 (SW/4 SW/4 equivalent), of Irregular Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each of the diversely-owned leases shall be measured with allocation meters.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.


Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

This administrative order approves off-lease measurement of oil and gas production for the present and future wells.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
