Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 19.15.15.13 NMAC and 19.15.4.12.A(3) NMAC.

A standard spacing unit in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool consists of 320-acres comprising a half-section. Your proposed non-standard spacing unit consists of the N/2 N/2 of the section.

The applicant is seeking this non-standard spacing unit for land reasons, because there is an existing 160-acre voluntary unit in the S/2 N/2 of Section 25, in which no well has been proposed. Further, Matador Production Company will not object to a non-standard spacing unit in the S/2 N/2 of Section 25.

It is understood that you have given due notice of this application to all operators or owners to whom notice is required by Division Rule 19.15.4.12.A (3) NMAC and no objections have been received.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 19.15.15.11.B (2), the above-described non-standard gas spacing unit is hereby approved.
