ADMINISTRATIVE POOL/LEASE COMMINGLING ORDER

Pursuant to your application received on March 30, 2017, XTO Energy, Inc. (OGRID 5380) is hereby authorized to surface commingle gas production from the following pools located in Section 14, Township 30 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico;

FULCHER KUTZ PICTURED CLIFFS (GAS)	(77200)
BASIN DAKOTA (PRORATED GAS)	(71599)

and from the following diversely owned fee and federal leases in said Section, Township, and Range in San Juan County, New Mexico.

Pool:	Fulcher Kutz Pictured Cliffs (Gas)

The combined spacing units for these wells include the N/2 of Section 14, Township 30 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The commingled gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Gem Well No. 1 and Taft Gas Com Well No.1 shared Central Tank Battery (CTB) located in Unit A of Section 14, Township 30 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:

The wells shall be measured with a combination of metering and subtraction. The Taft Gas Com Well No.1 shall be metered continuously prior to commingling with the Gem Well No. 1. Production from the Gem Well No. 1 shall be determined by subtracting the metered production at the central delivery point minus the metered production at the Taft Gas Com Well No.1.

No commingling of liquids shall occur.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.(C) (2) NMAC.

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

Subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management.

The operator shall notify the Aztec District office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
