
Dear Mr. Catanach:

In addition, we object because this application is not in the best interest of all owners within the Unit and the general public.

Without a full understanding of how production costs will be allocated to our clients and others, it would be inappropriate for this Application to be approved. Hence, we object and request that a formal hearing be set and the applicant set forth the basis on which such minerals will be extracted and how costs will be allocated among the mineral owners.

Matador Production Company (OGRID No. 228937) seeks administrative approval for off-lease measurement and approval to surface lease commingle oil and gas production from the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool (Pool Code 98220) *from all existing and future wells and existing and future leases* drilled in the following areas of diverse ownership in Township 23 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, in Eddy County, New Mexico:

(a) The 320-acre standard spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of Section 13. This pooled spacing unit is currently dedicated to the Joe Coleman 13-23S-27E RB No. 208H Well (API No. 30-015-44060). This well will produce from the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool (Pool Code 98220). The spacing unit is subject to Division Order R-14295, which pooled certain uncommitted interest owners for the Joe Coleman 13-23S-27E RB No. 208H Well.

(b) The 320-acre standard spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of Section 14. This pooled spacing unit is currently dedicated to the Kathy Coleman 14-23S-27E RB No. 208H Well (API No. 30-015-44058). This well will produce from the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool (Pool Code 98220). The spacing unit is subject to Division Order R-14293, which pooled certain uncommitted interest owners for the Kathy Coleman 14-23S-27E RB No. 208H Well.

Pursuant to NMAC 19.15.12.7, approved spacing units with diverse ownership are considered separate leases for surface commingling purposes. Matador seeks authority to surface commingle production according to the provisions of NMAC 19.15.12.10.C *from all existing and*



future wells in these separate areas of diverse ownership at a surface facility located in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 14. Pursuant to 19.15.12.10(C)(4)(g), Matador also seeks authority to commingle production from future leases and wells located along the Longwood RB Pipeline, with notice provided only to interest owners within future leases. Prior to commingling, gas production from each well will be separately metered using individual test separators with calibrated orifice meters that are manufactured to AGA specifications. Oil production from each well will also be separately metered using a turbine meter.

Exhibit 1 is a land plat showing Matador's current development and gathering system in the subject area. The plat identifies the wellbores, the spacing units, and the common surface facility located in NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 14. The acreage is all fee lands.

Exhibit 2 is a completed Application for Surface Commingling (Diverse Ownership) and Off-Lease Measurement Form C-107-B.

Exhibit 3 is an in depth engineering explanation of Matador's commingling process.

Exhibit 4 is a C-102 for each of the wells within the existing spacing units.

Exhibit 5 is a diagram of the surface facilities.

Exhibit 6 is a list of the interests affected by this request for approval to off-lease measure and surface commingle oil and gas production. A copy of this application with all attachments has been sent by certified mail to all affected parties advising them that if they have an objection they must file it in writing with the division within 20 days from the date the division receives Matador's application.

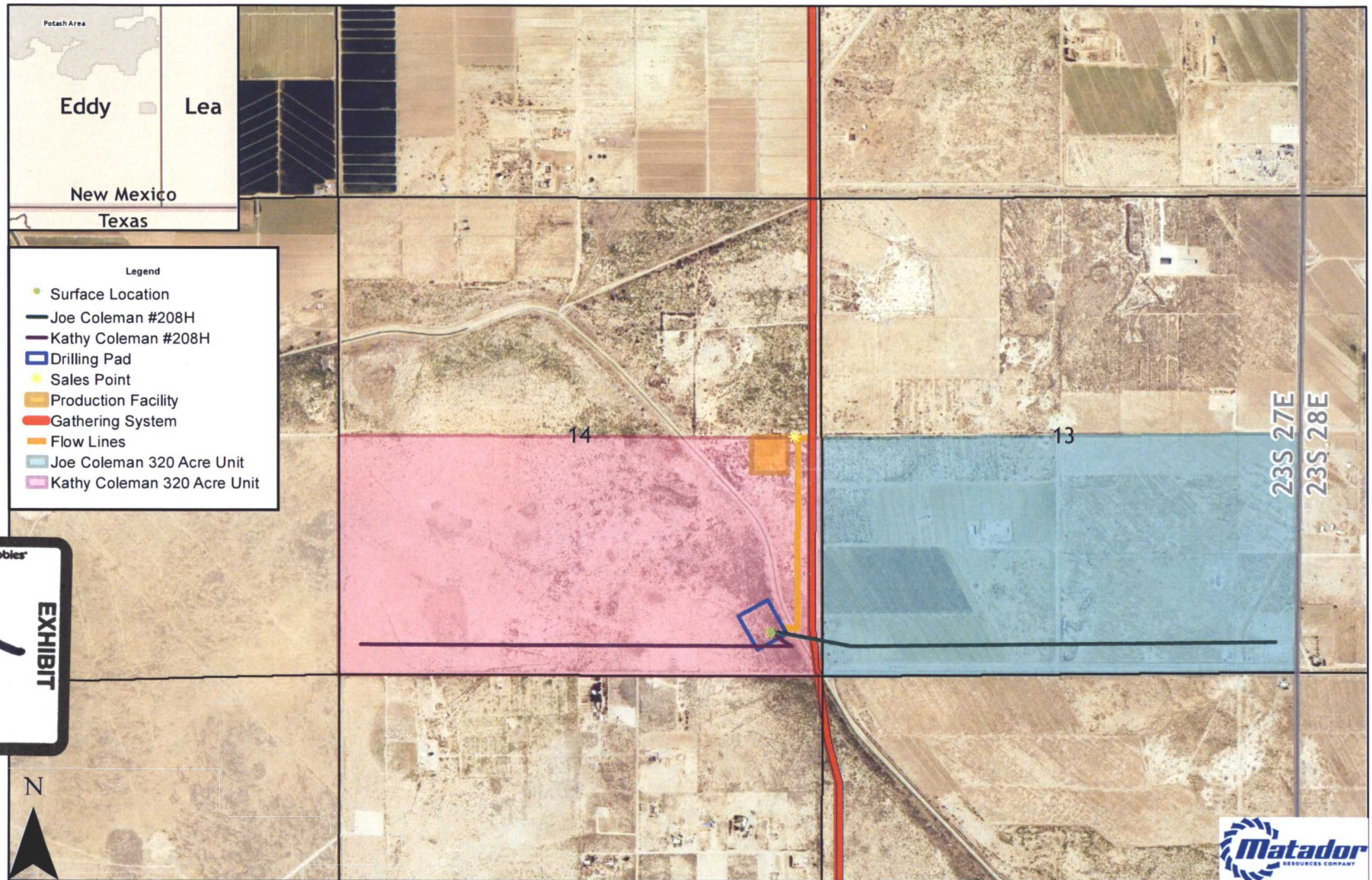

To Whom This May Concern,

Matador Production Company ("Matador"), OGRID: 228937, requests to commingle current oil and gas production from two (2) distinct wells located on the Lands and future production from the Lands as described herein. Both wells will be metered through a test separator with an oil turbine meter and gas orifice meter. The gas commingling will occur after individual measurement at each well. Gas exiting each well test flows into one gathering line, as depicted on **Exhibit A**, the Longwood Gathering. Each well on the Lands will have its own test separator with an orifice meter manufactured and assembled in accordance with American Gas Association (AGA) specifications. All primary and secondary Electronic Flow Measurement (EFM) equipment is tested and calibrated by a reputable third party measurement company in accordance with industry specifications.

The orifice meter is the preferred measurement device utilized by midstream and E&P companies in natural gas measurement. The gas samples are obtained at the time of the meter testing/calibration and the composition and heating value are determined by a laboratory in accordance with American Petroleum Institute (API) specifications to ensure accurate volume and Energy (MMBTU) determinations. See example from Fesco Laboratory attached as **Exhibit B** hereto.

The flow stream from each wellhead is demonstrated in the Process Flow Diagram (PFD) attached as **Exhibit A** hereto. The PFD shows that the water, oil, and gas leave the wellbore and flow into a wellhead test separator which separates the oil, gas, and water. The oil is measured via turbine meter which is calibrated periodically by a third party measurement company for accuracy. The gas is measured on a volume and MMBTU basis by an orifice meter and supporting EFM equipment in accordance with American Petroleum Institute (API) Chapter 21.1. The gas is then

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sent into a gathering line where it is commingled with each of the other wells' metered gas. The gathering line gas is then metered by another orifice meter at the tank battery check to show the total volume of gas leaving the Tank Battery. This meter is tested and calibrated in accordance with industry specifications and volume and energy are determined on an hourly, daily, and monthly basis. Once the gas exits this final tank battery sales check it travels directly into a third party sales connect meter. Longwood has its own orifice meter that measures the gas for custody transfer. These meters are also calibrated periodically to ensure the measurement accuracy.

In conclusion, all the oil and gas produced on the Lands is and will be metered at each wellhead and allocated correctly using the same measurement equipment as the pipeline sales measurement specifications accepted by API as industry standard.

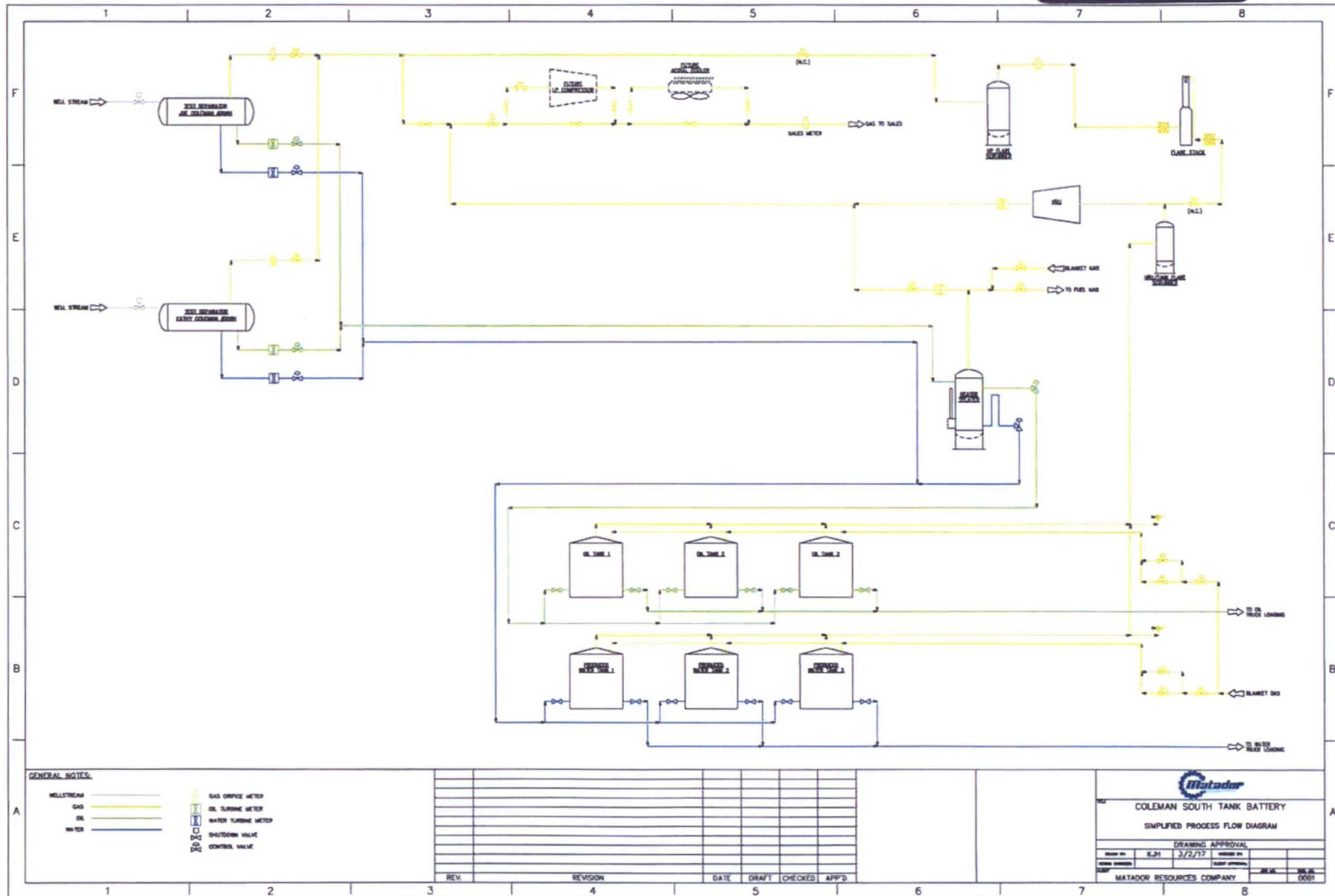

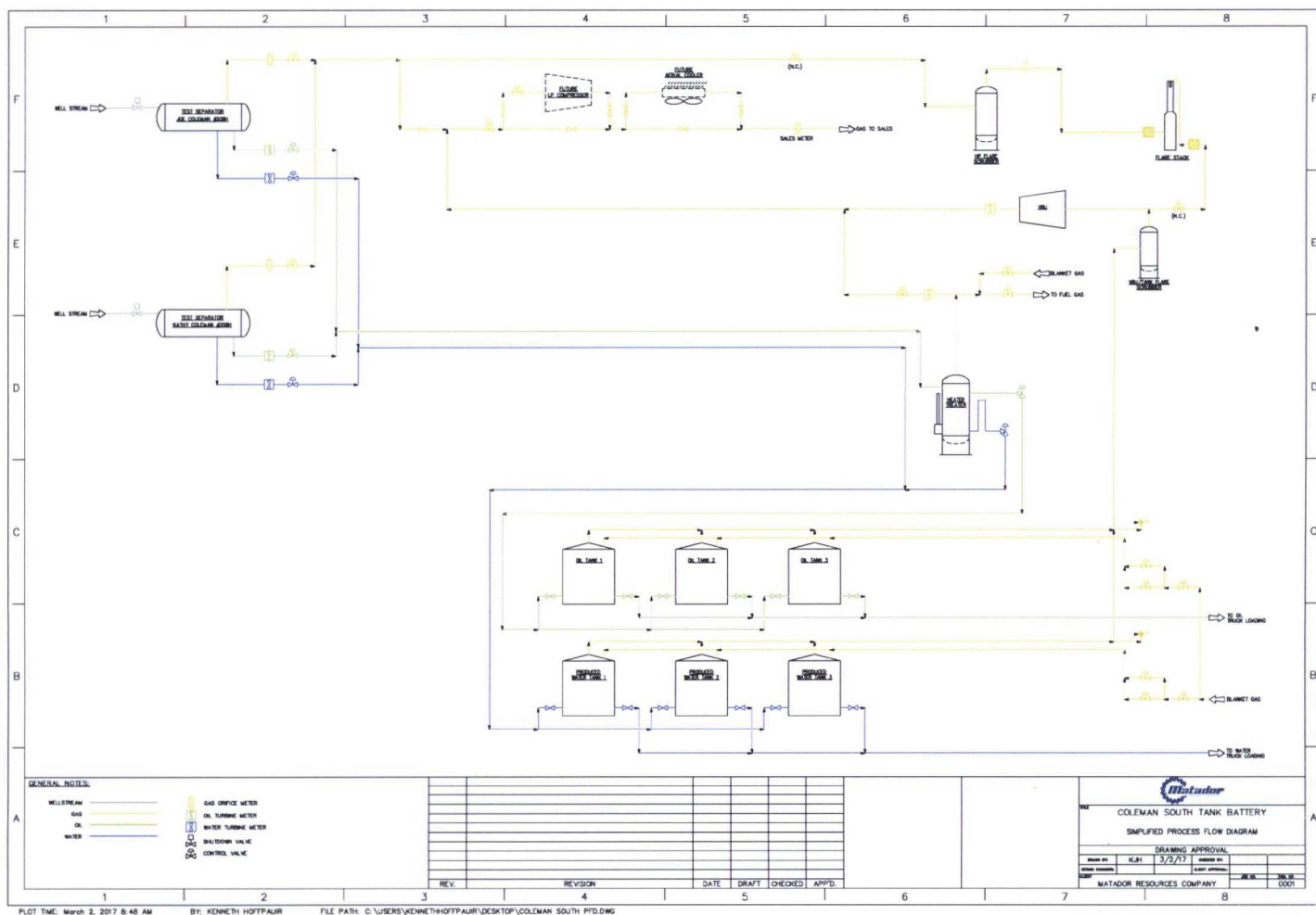
