The spill resulted when a 2 1/2" X 6" nipple on the water transfer line failed from apparent external corrosion. The nipple and approximately 30' of pipe was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The area affected includes 70' X 58' of the battery pad and 10' X 566' of pasture land. Approximately 14 bbls of produced water and 18 bbls of rain water was pickup with a vacuum truck. Delineation will be done to determine the necessary clean up procedures.
