There was trash in the fly gas system on the heater treater preventing water from dumping into the tank. Therefore, both water and oil was dumping into the oil tank and overfilled it by \sim 5-6 bbls. All fluids were contained inside lined SPCC containment and were 100% recoverable. The environment was not impacted by this spill.
