Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. ("Devon") respectfully requests administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for the Fighting Okra 18-19 Fed 5H well to be completed in the WC-025 G-09 S253336D; UPPER WOLFCAMP Pool (98094), API Number has not been assigned. As shown on the enclosed C-102, the permitted surface location is 375' FNL and 2605' FWL of Section 18-T26S-R34E, with a permitted bottom hole location 330' FSL and 2340' FEL of Section 19-T26S-R34E. The projected FTP (first take point) is expected to be approximately 330' FNL and 2340' FEL of Section 18-T26S-R34E and projected LTP (last take point) is expected to be approximately 330' FSL and 2340' FEL of Section 19-T26S-R34E. The reason for permitting this well at an unorthodox location is to maximize recovery.

Please be advised that Devon and Chevron U.S.A. Inc., combined, own 100% of the Federal leasehold interest in all of Sections 18 and 19-T26S-R34E, as well as Section 7-T26S-R34E offsetting to the north. EOG Resources, Inc. ("EOG") is the leaseholder of offsetting interest to the south in Section 30-T26S-R34E. EOG has been notified of this application via certified mail to the address shown on the enclosed list labeled "Notified Parties".

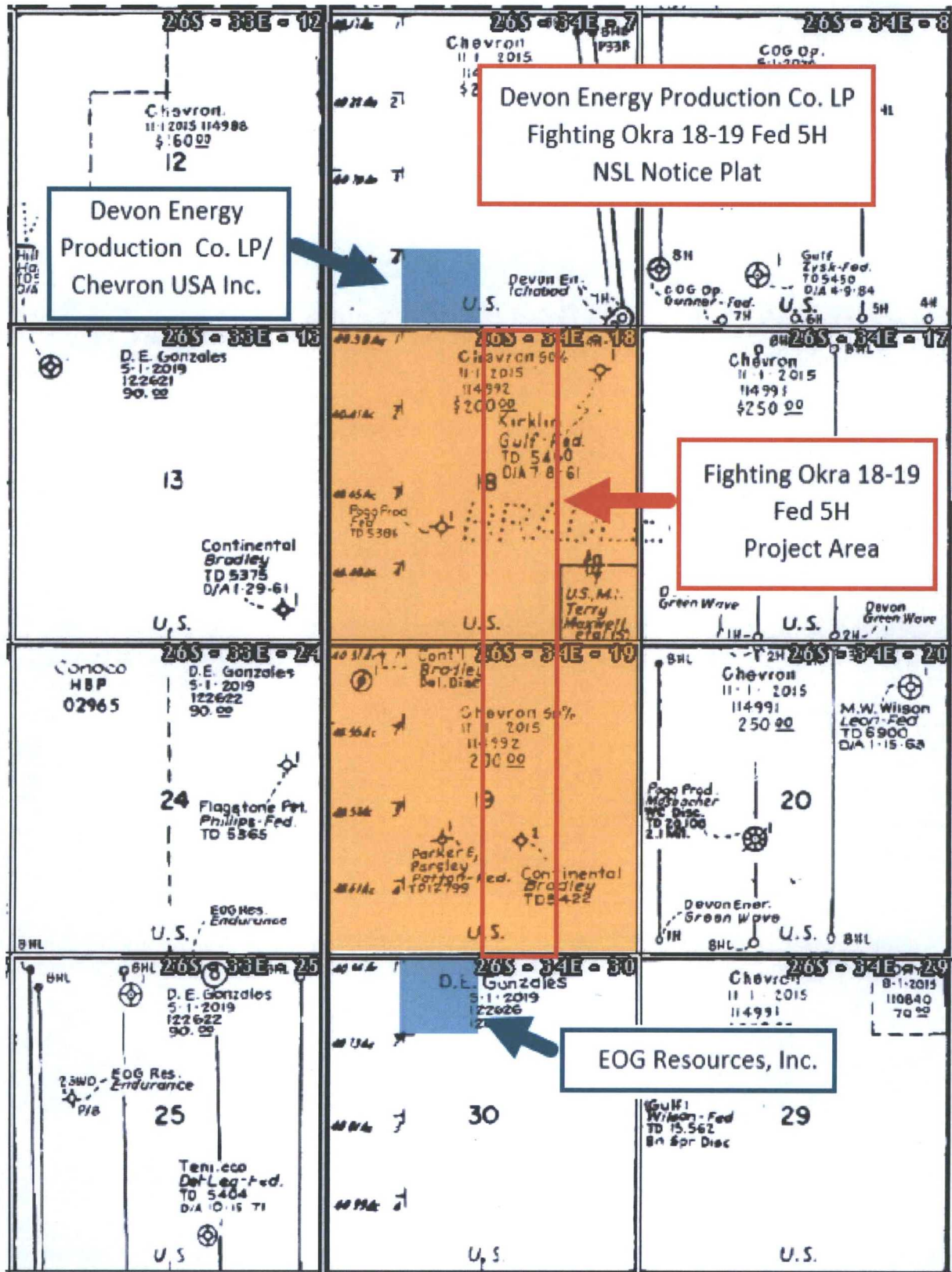
