The combined project area for these wells include the W/2 E/2 and W/2 of Section 27, and the W/2 E/2 and W/2 of Section 34, all in Township 24 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Hearns 34 Central Tank Battery (CTB) located in Unit M, Section 34, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:

The oil and gas production from each of the diversely-owned leases shall be measured with allocation meters. The oil and gas production from each well will flow into a dedicated 3-phase separator. Each stream shall be measured individually after it exits the separator, before commingling with the other wells.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

After initial notification, future wells that will produce from the pools and leases approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 19.15.12.10 C (4) NMAC and 19.15.4.12.A (8) NMAC.

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office upon commencement of commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the New Mexico State Land Office before commencing commingling operations.
