
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Upon the reclamation process of the battery, impacted soils were encountered.

The affected area was approximately 25' X 35' within the primary battery. Impacted soils have been excavated and taken to an NMOCD approved facility. Horizontal/Vertical delineation samples collected (enclosed). Based off of results, surface owner allowed backfilling of excavation to allow for upcoming core rig sampling (details to be submitted on a work plan). **Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approximately 158', per NMOSE), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0.**
