Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Due to produced water transfer pump malfunction, the produced water tanks overfilled and released approximately 68.25BBLS of produced water into the lined secondary containment. The wells were stopped and the transfer pump was reset.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Approximately 68.25 BBLS of produced water was released. Approximately 68.25 BBLS of produced water was recovered via the dispatched vacuum truck. All fluid stayed inside the lined SPCC containment. Once fluids were removed the liner was visually inspected by Devon field staff for any pinholes or punctures and none were found. Based on this inspection there is no evidence that the spill fluids left containment.
