Administrative Order NSP-194-A

Dear Mr. Mashburn:

Reference is made to your application dated May 4, 1998, for a 120-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 16: N/2 NE/4 and SW/4 NE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to the existing Hansen State Well No. 7 (API No. 30-025-30849), located at a standard gas well location 900 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 16.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, Doyle Hartman, Oil Operator is hereby authorized to operate the above-described non-standard 120-acre gas spacing and proration unit, with allowable assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 5 of said special pool rules based upon the unit size of 120 acres.
