RE: Condition of Approval for Extension Section 30 Recycling Containment and Facility #3RF-3 April 10 – May 6

## Dear Mr. Perrin,

Pursuant to Order R-14314, WPX submitted a C-103 for a 6-month extension request for cessation of operations on August 23, 2017, for the Section 30 Recycling Containment and Facility (#3RF-3) located in Section 30, Township 31N, Range 5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Approval of the 6-month extension was granted by Director David Catanach on August 25, 2017. Conditions of Approval (COA) of the C-103 are listed below. This report is being submitted to satisfy the monthly report requirement.

## 1.0 Conditions of Approval

Approval of the extension was granted with the following COA:

- 1) Take necessary actions to keep fresh water accumulation within the containment to a minimum and prevent damage from freezing.
- 2) Inspect and take photographs of the Facility weekly.
- In the event of leaks of damage to the Facility, the operator must do the following.
  - a. Notify OCD District III within 72 hours of knowledge of leaks or damage.
  - Submit a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to repair leaks or damage within seven days of notification above.
  - c. Upon OCD's approval of the CAP, complete repairs per the OCD-approved schedule.
- 4) By the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, submit monthly reports to OCD District III of inspection results with photographs and progress on CAP's if any.
- 5) Verify liner integrity before returning the containment to service.

## 2.0 Weekly Inspections

LOGOS continues to monitor the condition of the Section 30 Recycling Containment. Attached is a summary of weekly inspections conducted at the containment from April 10 - May 6. Also attached is a photograph log documenting site conditions during April 10 - May 6.

#### 3.0 Recent Event Summary

- A small volume of water remains in containment due to rain.
- Minimal amount of rain water and snowmelt was pumped from the leak detection over the past month.
- O.R.E. identified 14 holes and repairs were conducted by O.R.E on 4/17/18. Repairs were vacuum tested and verified as good.
- 04/18/18 3200bbls fresh water was pumped into the leak detection and 2 leaks were identified. 4/20 to 5/3/18 the water was pumped back out to the storage tanks. 5/4/18 Stormwater inside the containment was pumped out.



Waiting on pond to dry out, then have the 2 leaks repaired.

• LOGOS personnel continue to search and inspect the liner for any potential areas of concern along the base of the containment.


